To launch the competitive entrance examination into level one of the Engineering Programs of the School of Geology and Mining Engineering of the University of Ngaoundere, for the 2026/2027 academic year.

Mindful of Decison N°18260039/MINESUP/SG/DAUQ/SDEAC of 17th february 2026 to set the schedule of competitive entrance examinations into faculties and schools of Cameroon State Universities and schools under the academic supervisory authority of MINESUP, for the 2026-2027 academic year;

DECIDES AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1: A competitive written examination for admission into level one of the Engineering Programs of the School of Geology and Mining Engineering of the University of Ngaoundéré has been launched, for the 2026/2027 academic year, in the following departments and specialties, and in accordance with the number of places available listed below:

Article 2: (1) The competitive entrance examination is organized in a single session for Cameroonians of both sexes and who are holders of the following certificates:

- the Baccalauréat Certificate C, D, E, F ou TI;
- the GCE Advanced Level in at least two (02) science subjects/papers, and the GCE Ordinary Level obtained in one session with at least four (04) subjects/papers including at least two (02) science subjects/papers, and excluding "Religious Knowledge", the relevant science subjects/papers being: Biology, Chemistry, Computer Sciences, Geology, Mathematics and Physics;
- any other diploma/certificate recognized by the Minister of Higher Education as equivalent or in exemption to the Baccalauréat Certificate or the GCE Advanced Level and including the subjects/papers required for application in the specialty solicited.

(2) Candidates who are holders of foreign diplomas/certificates have to present the order granting equivalence issued by the Minister of Higher Education, or the acceptance slip for a diploma equivalence application. However, where the case arises, their final admission shall be possible only on the presentation of proof of having obtained the equivalence of the required diploma/certificate within the date limits specified by the competent authority.

Article 3: (1) Foreign candidates from member countries of the Economic and Monetary Community of Central Africa (EMCCA) having ratified the texts relating to national treatment of students may be authorized to sit for the examination under the same academic conditions and based on the number of places available, in accordance with the regulation in force.

(2) Foreign candidates from non member countries of EMCCA and those from member countries, including Cameroon, who do not sit for the competitive written examination may be selected by study of application files and based on the number of places available, if they are beneficiaries of a scholarship from their governments or from a national or international organization which pledges to pay the tuition fees relating to their status. Nevertheless, the number of places for admission through the study of application files shall not exceed **10% of the total number of places available**.

(3) Candidates sitting for the competitive entrance examination into level one of the engineering program must not be more than **twenty eight (28) years old as from 1st January 2026**.

Article 4: Candidates' files shall comprise all of the following documents:

- an application form to sit for the examination, to be filled and fiscal stamped at the rate of **1500 FCFA** by the candidate, to be collected from one of the following places:
 - The ten (10) Regional delegations for Secondary Education,
 - The branch of the University of Ngaoundere at Nkolbisson-Yaounde,
 - The Ministry of Higher Education (Department of University Accreditations and Quality),
 - School of Geology and Mining Engineering (EGEM) at Meiganga (Admissions, statistics, diplomas and certification office);The application form to sit for the examination can also be downloaded from the EGEM Internet website (<http://egem-ndere.com>);
- a certified true photocopy of birth certificate, dated not more than three (03) months ago, signed by the competent authority ;
- photocopies of results transcripts of the Probatoire or the GCE/OL and the Baccalauréat or the GCE/AL, dated, signed or certified by the competent Examination Boards ;
- a certified true photocopy of the Baccalauréat or the GCE/AL, or an equivalent diploma/certificate recognized by the Ministry of Higher Education, dated not more than three (03) months ago, or a Success Testimonial signed or certified by the competent Examination Boards. Only candidates sitting for the **2026** GCE/AL or the Baccalauréat shall be authorized to write the examination awaiting the required diplomas/certificates ; however, where the case arises, their final admission shall be possible only on the presentation of proof of having obtained the required diploma/certificate within the date limits specified by the competent authority ;
- a medical certificate issued by a medical doctor working with the Administration, dated not more than three (03) months ago, testifying that the candidate is physically and mentally apt to work as an engineer. Notably that he/she has no physiological impairments especially concerning speech, hearing, sight or movement ;
- a certificate of non-conviction (bulletin n°3) dated not more than three (03) months ago ;
- a receipt showing payment of the sum of **twenty thousands (20 000) CFA francs** as examination fees in the **ÉCOLE DE GÉOLOGIE ET D'EXPLOITATION MINIÈRE (EGEM)**, Bank Account No

- : 10005 00101 09528711001 43, MEIGANGA, issued by AFRILAND FIRST BANK. No other mode of payment shall be accepted ;
- four (04) recent passport size (4x4) photographs of the candidate ;
 - an A4 size envelope bearing postal stamps respecting current rates (500 FCFA) and carrying the exact address and phone/WhatsApp number of the candidate;
 - an A3 size envelope not bearing stamp;
 - a proof of having obtained the equivalence of/exemption of the required diploma/certificate or the acceptance slip for a diploma equivalence application as concerns any other foreign diploma.

Article 5: (1) The examination fees for the competitive entrance examination amount to twenty thousands (20 000) CFA francs to be paid at the bank AFRILAND FIRST BANK, Bank Account No : 10005 00101 09528711001 43, MEIGANGA. The deposit must be done directly in an AFRILAND FIRST BANK Agency.

(2) Candidates selected by study of files have to pay tuition fees amounting to one (01) million CFA francs, in accordance with decree n°93/033 of 19 January 1993, modifying some provisions of decree n°79/186 of 17 May 1979 to state the payable amount of tuition fees.

Article 6: (1) Complete files shall be submitted latest **Wednesday 21st October 2026** at one of the following places:

- The ten (10) Regional delegations for Secondary Education,
- The branch of the University of Ngaoundere at Nkolbisson-Yaounde,
- The Ministry of Higher Education (Department of University Accreditations and Quality),
- School of Geology and Mining Engineering (EGEM) at Meiganga (Admissions, statistics, diplomas and certification office).

(2) Only candidates having submitted a complete regulatory file shall be authorized to sit for the examination.

Article 7: The written examination shall be conducted on **Sunday 25th october 2026** in the following centers: **Bafoussam, Bamenda, Bertoua, Buea, Douala, Ebolowa Garoua, Maroua, Ngaoundere and Yaounde.**

Article 8: (1) The paper for the written examination is based on the following subjects for all the specialties:

Subjects	Duration
Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Geology, Psychotechnical Test, General knowledge & Language.	5 H

(2) The syllabuses of the examination are based on the Baccalauréat C, D, E, F and TI programs or the GCE/AL programs in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Geology subjects.

(3) The paper of the written examination has a mark range from zero (0) to twenty (20).

Article 9: (1) After due deliberation by the jury, the jury shall establish, according to specialty and in order of merit, the tentative list of candidates for final admission.

(2) The candidate's performance in the written examination or in the final admission cannot be carried forward from one academic year to another.

(3) The final results shall be published by the Minister of Higher Education.

(4) Fraudulent admission following failure to enforce the required condition for diploma, grade or age exposes the candidate concerned to automatic expulsion at any time without any due form and procedure.

Article 10: The composition of the jury cited in article 9 above shall be established in a special text by the Minister of Higher Education in accordance with the regulation in force.

Article 11: The examination fees mentioned in article 5 above are non-refundable.

Article 12: The Rector of the University of Ngaoundere, the Director of University Accreditations and Quality and the Director of the School of Geology and Mining Engineering are, each in his own sphere, are responsible for the implementation of the present decision which shall be registered and published in English and in French wherever necessary.
