



DECISION N° 2026/344 UN/R/VR-EPDTIC/DAAC/DGEM of 26 AUG 2026

Announcing the Competitive Entrance Examination and fixing the number of places available for admission into the first Year of **Professional Masters in Exploitation and Management of the Mining and Petroleum Environment (EMMPE)**, of the School of Geology and Mining Engineering (EGEM) of the University of Ngaoundere for **2026/2027** academic year.

- Mindful of the Resolution N°07/2023/UN/PCA/R of November 30, 2023 of the 49th session of the Board of Directors of the University of Ngaoundere ratifying Resolution N°13/CU/30/11/2023 of the University Council validating the project of creation of 06 Professional Masters at the School of Geology and Mining (EGEM);

On the proposal of the Director of the School of Geology and Mining (EGEM) of the University of Ngaoundere,

Decides:

Article 1: A Competitive Entrance Examination for the recruitment of **thirty (30) candidates** into the first Year of **Professional Masters in Exploitation and Management of the Mining and Petroleum Environment (EMMPE)** of the School of Geology and Mining Engineering (EGEM) of the University of Ngaoundere for **2026/2027** academic year.

Article 2: The said competitive entrance cited in article 1 is open to Cameroonians of both sexes and also to foreigners fulfilling the following qualifications: holders of a Bachelor's degree or equivalent in economics, management, law, marketing, accounting, earth sciences, and geography. However, direct admission to the first semester of the Master's 2 program is only for design engineers or any other diploma recognized as equivalent by the Ministry of Higher Education;

Article 3: Application files must, under penalty of rejection, include the following documents and must be submitted **before October 31, 2026, strict deadline:**

• A duly completed and stamped 1500 FCFA competition registration form by the candidate;
this form is made available to candidates at one of the following locations:

- School of Geology and Mining Engineering (EGEM) at Meiganga (Admissions, statistics, diplomas and certification office),
- The branch of the University of Ngaoundere at Nkolbisson-Yaounde,

The application form to sit for the examination can also be downloaded through the link **<https://concours.egem-ndere.com/>**

- A certified photocopy of your birth certificate dated less than 3 months ago;
- A certified photocopy of your diploma qualifying for the competitive examination;
- A medical certificate issued by a civil servant doctor dated less than 3 months ago;
- Four (04) 4x4 passport photos;
- A criminal record extract (bulletin N° 3) dated less than three (03) months ago;

- A receipt for payment of twenty thousand (20,000) CFA francs in competitive examination fees to the account **ÉCOLE DE GÉOLOGIE ET D'EXPLOITATION MINIÈRE (EGEM), No. 10005 00101 09528711001 43, MEIGANGA**, issued by AFRILAND FIRST BANK. No other payment method will be accepted;
- An A4 envelope stamped at the current rate (500 FCFA) and bearing the candidate's exact address and telephone/WhatsApp number;
- An unstamped A3 envelope;
- Proof of obtaining the equivalence or the receipt for submitting the equivalence application or admission with exemption for any other foreign diploma

Article 4: The total cost of the program is 1,200,000 FCFA (one million two hundred thousand) FCFA. This amount will be payable in two annual installments as follows:

- **First year (Master 1):** 500,000 (five hundred thousand) FCFA to be paid in two installments: 1st installment (300,000 FCFA) and 2nd installment (200,000 FCFA)
- **Second year (Master 2):** 700,000 (seven hundred thousand) FCFA to be paid in three installments: 1st installment (350,000 FCFA), 2nd installment (250,000 FCFA), and 3rd installment (100,000 FCFA).

Article 5: After publication of the results, successful candidates will have 10 working days to report to the Institution to complete the registration formalities. After this period, they will be considered to have resigned and will be replaced by candidates on the waiting list, based on their ranking on this list.

Article 6: The Director of the School of Geology and Mining (EGEM) of the University of Ngaoundere is responsible for the implementation of this Decision, which will be recorded and communicated wherever necessary.
